Nursery 48 Hours Opening from September 2023.

From September 2023 nursery will be open 48 weeks a year.

This provision will also be open to children in reception, enabling them to access it in the school holidays.

Miss Smith and Miss Naylor, who will continue to work in nursery during term time, will head up the holiday care provision.

We will shut for a week at Christmas, a week at Easter and 2 weeks in the summer
The exact dates shut, details of pricing and booking will be announced in September.

For nursery parents who are eligible for 30 hours funding and wish to use this provision, we will have individual conversations with you in September about how we spread your funding.
