Jeans for Genes is the UK's only awareness and raising event which supports 1 in 10 families across the UK affected by a genetic condition.

1 in every 25 children have a genetic condition. Some are well known, some are invisible, and others are incredibly rare with life altering consequences.

All have their challenges and need specialised help, support and services.

Which is where we come in! Jeans for Genes week is a great opportunity to come together, show support and celebrate difference.

PE KIT DAYS

Please send your Child in their School PE kit on the following days.

(Please note that children should come to school in their PE kit on these days regardless of whether they tell you that they are doing PE, Forest Schools, Art or music).

Reception - Thursday. The children will alternate between PE & Outdoor Adventures so will need some wellies to keep in school as well.

Year 1 - 1 Willow - Monday & Wednesday and 1 Oak Wednesday & Thursday

Year 2 - Wednesdays - both classes (2 Cherry is doing Forest Schools on a Wednesday until October ½ term) and also Friday for 2 Beech & Monday for 2 Cherry.

Year 3 - Tuesday & Thursday

Year 4 - Thursdays & Fridays (4 Yew is doing Forest Schools until October ½ term)

Year 5 – Tuesdays

Year 6 - Tuesdays & Fridays (6 Birch is doing Forest Schools until October ½ term).
