Christmas Early Years Holiday Club

Opening Times and Fees

Monday 18th December – Friday 22nd December & Tuesday 2nd January 2024.

9.00am – 3.30 pm = £40 per day
9.00am – 1.00pm = £20 for a ½ day
8.00am – 5.15pm = £50 per day

There will be no holiday club provision week commencing Monday 25th December – Friday 30th December.

How to Book a place

The club is set up on Arbor and the booking window is open until 9.00am on Monday 11th December.

- Please select whether booking for a full or half day.
- If you use the extended option, either before or after school or both we will add an extra charge of £10 retrospectively when we return to school in January.
- If you decide to stay for a full day and have only booked ½ or require extra sessions when the club is running please agree with Miss Smith and charge will again be added retrospectively.

PE KIT DAYS
