FAIR ANNOUNCEMENTS

Only 1 week to go until the Ashlands Summer Fair 2024 and along with the family favourite activities such as the tombola, BBQ, bouncy castle, bar, pre-loved sale....we are excited to announce that we've got some furry and feathery friends making an appearance with a trio of Donkeys making their way from Blackpool for "plods around the playground" and a variety of Birds of Prey and reptiles which children will have the chance to learn about and to handle. We are also running an Athletics zone to get into the spirit of the Olympics.

Attached is a map of the fair so you all know what is happening and where it is. This is especially useful for new to Ashlands families who will be starting in September and who we always extend invitation to join us.

TOKENS

In parallel with school becoming cashless we are working to transition towards PTA events becoming cashless. This year we will be offering a token system where you can pre-buy on Arbor under school shop in denominations of £1 or on the day at the fair. To aid your decision in how much to buy below is a pricelist. Note the BBQ, Bar and Pre-loved stalls will accept card payments and the Enterprise Stalls will accept cash OR tokens as we would like the children to practice their monetary skills. Any pre-bought tokens on Arbor will be sent home on Thursday with your child / eldest child along with the wristbands (only 12+ require wristbands as under 12s are free).
