

# **Nursery - Summer Term 2**

Welcome back after the Half Term! This term we will be following the adventures of the 'Naughty Bus' As some people have already had trips away or will be thinking of future holidays, now is a good time for the children to think about different modes of transport and places to go.

**Literacy:** Our main text for this half term is the 'Naughty Bus'. We will be looking at the different types of transport and different places we could go!

We will introduce some history by looking at different modes of transport from the past.



### **Understanding of the World**

Children will develop an understanding of the past, using non-fiction texts to learn about different modes of transport used a long time ago.

As some children are going on holiday, it will be a good chance for children to share what countries they have visited and how they got there.

### **Communication and Language**

Develop language through role play using talk to organise themselves .

Creating their own bus to take on a journey and talk about where it has been.

Create their own ending to the story 'Naughty Bus' where will the bus go at night- time?

### **Maths**

As the sunflowers continue to grow, we will compare their heights using language of size.

We will begin to recognise numbers on a 5 frame

Use positional and directional language.

# Personal, Social and Emotional Development.

For those moving to Reception in September we will be thinking about their transition – having play sessions and story times in their new environment. Remembering rules without needing an adult to remind them.

### **Physical Development**

There will be lots of movement outside, den building, creating road tracks and using balance bikes and scooters.

Large and fine motor movements will include chalking, water paint and paint wheels. For children moving into Reception, we will encourage the use of a comfortable grip and good control when using pens.

Expressive Arts and Design Join different materials to make a bus!



#### Things you can do at home to help this half term

- If your child has not been on a bus, now could be the time!
- We will be discussing children's own experiences of going on a bus and other
  different transport. If you have any photos to share, to help your child to talk
  about their past experiences, please email me on <u>Claire.collin@ashlands.mlt.co.uk</u>
- Go to the library and find some non-fiction books on different types of transport.
- Tune your child into the different sounds they hear as different vehicles pass,: motorbikes, helicopters, ambulances,
- When discussing number at home, encourage children to note what they 'see' (use your eyes to subitise) rather than counting out objects. "2 birds on the grass" "did you see that lady had 3 dogs" "I've found a snail, oh looks there's another one, one and one more is two"
- We have many unnamed cardigans/jumpers please use a permanent pen or sticker to name cardigans and jumpers.
