Practise spelling the Year 1 Common Exception Words. These will be sent home each Friday. You could use chalks, paint, water and brushes, a tray of sand or rice or magnetic letter.	Practise counting lots of different sets of objects. How many ways can you group them? Roll a dice and find that amount of items in one minute.	Make a fact file about someone in your family. Can you use the Year 1 words you have been practicing to write a funny sentence?	Encourage your child to read regularly at home. Support them with their reading by asking questions about what they have read. Maybe talk to family members and ask them what books they are reading at the moment? Visit your local library and read three new books by your favourite author.	 This term we are learning all about ourselves. Our topic is called Mighty Me! Here are some ideas if you wish to carry on your learning at home: Create a family collage or picture. Write about your pet or a pet you wish you had. Help your grown up to make your favourite meal. Draw a map of where you live and mark your favourite places.

<u>Year 1 Information:</u>

- The bell rings at 8:55am and children need to line up at the orange pencil in the playground to see Mrs Dalton (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday) and Miss Day (Thursday, Friday).
- School finishes at 3:30pm and children will leave through the year 1 door. Please make sure you let us or the office know if somebody different is picking up your child. Saplings children will be collected by staff.
- Children can bring a small bag to school or a school book bag. Please make sure they bring their reading book and reading record every day. They do not need a pencil case or snack, as this is provided. If children choose to bring a snack from home, this must be fruit or vegetables only.
- Children should bring a named water bottle every day. This will come home with them every evening.
